Zonal/Local:- The Zonal and Local reservations shall be followed as per the Telangana Public Employment (Organisation of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order,2018 videG.O.Ms.No.124 General Administration (SPF-MC) Department dated 30.08.2018 andG.O.Ms.No.128 General Administration (SPF-I) Department dated30.06.2021, read with G.O.Ms.No 217 General Administration (SPF-II) Department dated 04.08.2021, issued with respect to Scheme for organization of local cadres in Women Development & Child Welfare Department.

Rule of Reservation:-

 The Reservation and eligibility in terms of General Rule 22 & 22 (A) (3) of State and Subordinate Service Rules are applicable.

2. PROCEDURE OF SELECTION:

- 1. The selection of candidates for appointment to the posts will be made by OMR based(objective type)examination. The final selection of these posts will be based on marks secured in the examination.
- 2. In case of a tie in the total marks, age shall be the criteria for deciding the selection of a candidate. If the tie persists, date of entry into service of the WD&CW Dept., shall be considered and if the tie further continues, higher Qualification shall be the criteria for selection.
- 3. Mere securing minimum qualifying marks does not vest any right in a candidate for being considered for selection.
- 4. Provisionally Shortlisted candidates have to produce original documents and other particulars on the day of verification itself. If candidate fails to produce any of the required certificates and if the particulars furnished by her in the Application do not tally with the original documents produced by her, then her candidature will be rejected/disqualified without any further correspondence. As candidature for the recruitment is processed through Computer/Electronic devices based on the particulars furnished in the Application Form, the candidate is advised to fill in all the relevant particulars carefully.

DEBARMENT:

- a) Any candidate furnishing in-correct information or making false declaration regarding her eligibility at any stage or suppressing any information is liable to be debarred, and summarily rejection of their candidature for this recruitment.
- b) If any malpractice and unfair means are noticed at any stage of the Recruitment, the candidate is liable to be debarred, and summarily rejection of their candidature for this recruitment.
- c) Any candidate is or has been found impersonating or procuring impersonation by any person or resorting to any other irregular or improper means in connection with her candidature for selection or obtaining support of candidature by any means, such a candidate may in addition to rendering herself liable to criminal prosecution, will be debarred permanently from exam.
